## Sexual Assault is Against the Law!

It is sexual assault even if the person who touches you is:

- A person who helps you for example, caregiver, attendant, interpreter, doctor, therapist
- A person you know for example, boyfriend, girlfriend, husband, neighbour, co-worker, friend
- A stranger (person you do not know)
- A family member for example, cousin, brother, father, uncle, mother
- The same sex (gender)

No one has the right to touch you if you don't want.

Without permission (consent), it is Sexual Assault.

- Tell someone you trust: friend, teacher, doctor, nurse, relative, counsellor.
- Go to the hospital, see a doctor or go to a clinic.
